



- Open to all Taylor County 4-H Members ages 9-18
- Project will meet 4-5 times at Penn's Country Ham (8812) Liberty Rd, Campbellsville, KY 42718) or at the Taylor County Extension Office starting in March 2024.
- Youth will select, salt, wash, sock, cure and oil two smoked country hams.
- Youth are required to give a 3-5 minute speech on country hams at the Kentucky State Fair on August 15, 2024 in order to keep their 2nd ham.
- Youth are also required to participate in our County Speech & Demo Contest on Tuesday, March 26 at the Taylor County Extension Office.

USE YOUR CREATIVITY TO MAKE A PIGGY BANK AND START SAVING YOUR CHANGE!

Deliver your "piggy bank" to the Taylor County Extension Office by Friday, January 12th for display and judging.

County prizes will be awarded in the following age categories: K-3, 4-6, 7-8 & 9-12

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Entries must meet the following requirements to be eligible for judging:

- The bank cannot exceed 12 inches X 12 inches X 12 inches (1 square foot)
- Piggy banks must be able to hold coins (i.e., include a slot that has been cut to insert coins).
- Piggy banks must be created or decorated by the youth contestant.
- Plastic or ceramic banks may be used, but must be personally decorated.
- · Piggy banks DO NOT have to be in the shape of a pig.
- · You MAY use or repurpose other containers.
